BANROCK out crawled the field to take the early lead on the opening turn, set a slow pace facing token pressure while off the inside, finally met a test approaching the quarter pole, dug in determinedly when MY MAN LARS reached even terms, went head to head with that opponent, started edging away in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, then lasted over a fast-closing CLASSIC PACK to prove best in a tight photo. CLASSIC PACK unhurried for a half, was eased outward after entering the second turn, swung into contention with a three wide move nearing the head of the stretch, found his best stride during the final furlong, finishing with a flourish down the center of the course to just miss. MY MAN LARS raced three wide on both turns, applied token pressure on the pacesetter for six furlongs, made a move to take command approaching the quarter pole, raced heads apart with the winner until the sixteenth pole, held well to garner show honors. STEPASIDE tried a three wide bid on the far turn, flattened out. LOGIC WAY forwardly placed for six furlongs while travelling along the outside, tired. GIMME CREDIT took the inside route, was taken up nearing the far turn when KEY EVENT ducked inward, failed to threaten thereafter. KEY EVENT wide around the opening bend, ducked to the rail approaching the turn, steadily tired after going three-quarters.
